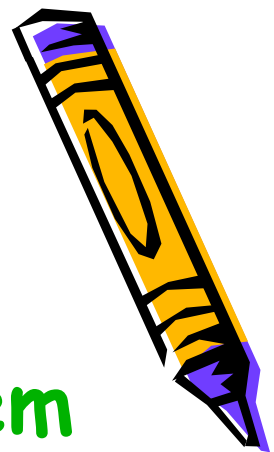

What is NYSIIS?

NYSIIS is the New York State Immunization Information System

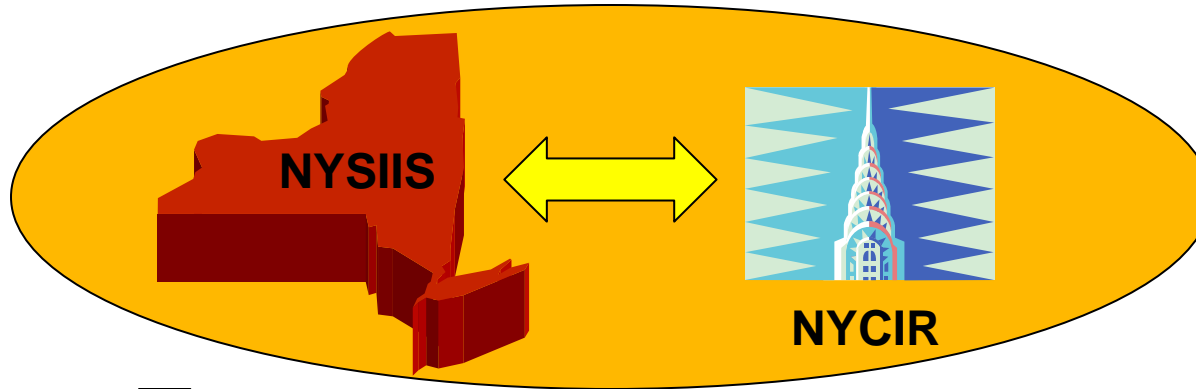
- Confidential, web-based data system
- Collects and consolidates vaccination information from multiple healthcare providers
- Legislatively mandated provider participation as of January 1, 2008 for immunizations given to children less than 19 years of age (including immunization histories)
- Lifespan system (with consent, age 19 years or older)



Immunization Registry Law

Who is required to report

- Vital Records: All births in NYS outside of NYC
- Public and private providers, including hospitals
- Only one report required to either NYSIIS or NYCIR, depending on where immunization administered



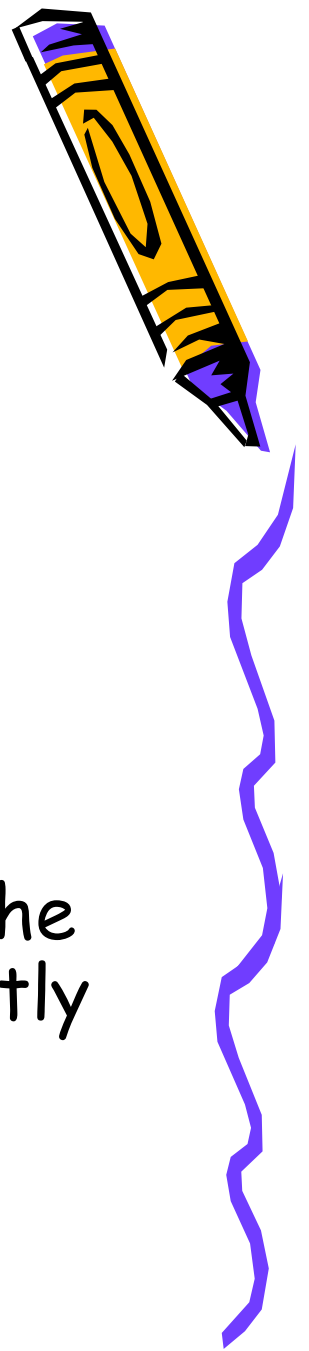
Who can have access to data

- Health care providers
- Hospitals
- State and Local Health Departments
- Certified Home Health Agencies
- Local Social Services districts*
- Office of Children and Family Services*
- Schools, including licensed day care centers*
- Health Maintenance Organizations and other 3rd party insurers*
- Parents (through HCP only)

*View-only access unless they administer immunizations



NYSIIS Stats



- System went live for providers on February 25, 2008.
- As of September 5, 2008, NYSIIS contains 1.2 million patients and 15.4 million immunizations.
 - 3,600 user accounts established from 1,700 participating organizations.
- Approximately 30% of children are in the system and this percentage varies greatly by region.



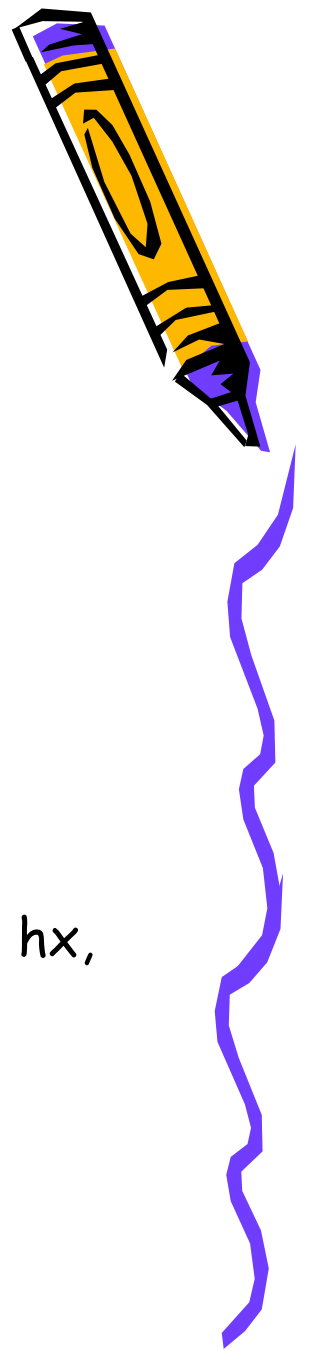
NYSIIS School Users



- Health care provider roll out remains priority through 2008.
 - Includes school based-health centers.
- Schools can have read-only access for student look up.
 - Data cannot be entered or edited by school users.
- Limited number of one hour School User webinar trainings are being offered during the Fall 2008

- Users **MUST** have their own NYSDOH Health Commerce System account to access NYSIIS.



School User Functions



- Find Student
 - Student Info, Immunization History, Recommended Vaccines
- Manage Lists
 - Create or edit up to 10 lists
- School Reports
 - Student list (name, DOB for each student in the selected list)
 - Student Immunization History list (name, DOB, imm hx, rec vacc for each student in the selected list)
 - Immunizations Due (name, DOB, imms due for each student in the selected list).
